

Be sure to use $8.5 in \times 11 in paper$. Your print settings should be set to normal.

Due to printer variations, margins may measure + or - 1/8ths of an inch.

Cut paper along the dashed line. Save this section for installation instructions.

- 1. Clean surface with soap and water then wipe dry with lint-free cloth.
- 2. Wipe surface with isopropyl achohol (70-90%) and let dry.
- 3. Place template edges in their directed positions.
- 4. Secure template in place with masking tape.
- 5. Before removing the adhesive liner, ensure "B", "r", and last "o" meet at the cut line.
- 6. Inspect surface one more time to ensure it is clean.
- 7. Remove adhesive liner
- 8. Lightly place the badge into place from left to right (adjust when needed) and line the badge up in the appropriate locations.
- 9. Once in the desired position, from left to right, firmly press and hold each letter in place for 10-15 seconds.
- 10. Wipe off the area and enjoy your new badge!

Note: Most vehicles from factory have a positive rake angle. Meaning the rear of the vehicle is higher than the front. This may attribute to an slight unlevel look once installed. The right end point of badge should be at cut line

Top of "o" should be at cut line

Gap should measure apprx. 2in (+/- 1/8th in.)
