

Removal

NOTE: Removal steps in this procedure may contain installation details.

- 1. Remove the front seats.



- 2. Release the retainers and remove the trim panel.




3. Remove the bolt covers.



4. Release the retainers and lower the steering column opening trim panel. Use the General Equipment: Interior Trim Remover




5. Open the glove compartment.




6. **NOTE:** Vehicles not equipped with a handle are equipped with a trim plate. The bolts and trim plate must be removed.


Remove the bolts and the handle or trim plate.




- 7. Remove the screws, release the reteianers and remove the lower instrument panel trim panel.
 - Disconnect the electrical connectors.




- 8. 1. Insert a trim tool between the selector lever boot and the trim ring to release the retainer tabs from the trim ring.
 - Use the General Equipment: Interior Trim Remover 2. Lift the selector lever boot upwards.




- 9. Release the retainers, feed the shift boot through the panel opening, and remove the floor console upper trim panel.
 - Disconnect the electrical connectors.


10. Remove the bolts and the console reinforcement bracket *Torque*: 22 lb.in (2.5 Nm)



11. Disconnect the floor console electrical connectors.



12. Remove the bolts, release the push pins and remove the floor console. *Torque*: 48 lb.in (5.4 Nm)
